## **A little reminder of just why we are here & what to pray about...**

Honduras has tens of thousands of deaf people, the vast majority of whom do not know a structured sign language. Without this ability, they simply cannot understand the Bible or who God is or even what a God is. The deaf in under-developed nations are among the largest unreached people groups in the world.

There are a few deaf ministries in Honduras and they are located in the largest cities. Praise to God for their diligent work for His glory. But, most of country does not have any outreach to the Deaf. We have been working for 3 years in the central part of the country, where the only outreaches are by the Jehovah's Witnesses. Most of the deaf we work with had no language when we met them. Only a few can read or write Spanish.

Teaching them how to communicate and explaining the Bible is a steady but fruitful process. Their growth is evident as they learn. Thank you for your prayers and assistance with our efforts to give God's Word the never before reached.
