They ran TV & radio announcements and this week we started a new class. 35 people showed up for the first class, mostly teachers and university students. What fast learners! As we explained our reason for being in Honduras - to enable the Deaf to have a relationship with our Savior Jesus Christ - most agreed to it's importance. And most also raised their hands when asked "how many here are Christians?". We desire the hearing Christian community to learn sign language so they can be equipped to reach their Deaf neighbors - may God be praised for this awesome development!
